Ride for the cure

"Women Only" ride benefits local survivor, research

Don't think that only characters in Hollywood movies try new, somewhat daring, hobbies after serious medical diagnoses.

For a real life example, look at Baltimore native Colette Nichols, 41, who was diagnosed in 2004 and again in 2006 with metastatic breast cancer. She'd always thought about riding a motorcycle, but it wasn't until her latest diagnosis that she decided to seriously pursue it as a hobby.

"I just started looking into it and thought I'd try it," said Nichols. "At first I hesitated but then I figured why not?"

The next thing Nichols knew she was searching for lessons and ways to rack up the 1000 "seat hours" she needs to participate in the Amazon Heart Thunder. All motorcycle riders at the event that takes them from Los Angeles to San Francisco will be breast cancer survivors.

Enter the staff of the Harley-Davidson Store of Baltimore. Tina Jarman, who oversees Marketing & Promotions there, was coordinating the area's first-ever Woman Only Ride, dubbed "Heels 2 Wheels."

Jarman had pledged the proceeds from the ride to the Susan G. Koman for the Cure, which supports breast cancer research and awareness, but she and her coworkers knew there was plenty they could offer Nichols.

From a helmet to lessons, Harley-Davidson of Baltimore has gone all out to prepare, advise and coach Nichols. In addition, they are collecting funds for her the day of the local 50-mile ride which will also include exhibitors ranging from Panera to Mary Kay cosmetics.

The ride will give Nichols a taste of what to expect at the September event in California, which is the first leg of an international motorcycle relay, organized by American Heart and sponsored internationally by Harley-Davidson, to raise awareness for breast cancer. All riders are breast cancer survivors.

"The experience of breast cancer impacts everyone who is forced to deal with it in profound and sometimes unexpected ways," says Megan Dwyer, co-Founder of Amazon Heart and one of the riders.

Although the women on the local ride won't share that medical history, they will have a chance to make a difference for those who do.

"Women [motorcycle enthusiasts] are looking for women mentors and this is a great way to meet them....and support Colette," said Jarman. "As she always says 'Bald chicks rock!'"
